In 2023, Red Mountain Grace served a record 171 families in one year, providing affordable and comfortable housing to families who otherwise may have had to sleep in their cars or in waiting rooms, or spend thousands of dollars on extended hotel stays. They currently have 19 apartments located throughout Birmingham, which are fully furnished and serve as an oasis for families in need of respite during medical treatments. Their goal is to meet physical needs by providing affordable housing while also meeting spiritual and emotional needs by providing support to families and showing them the love of Christ in their time of need. 




