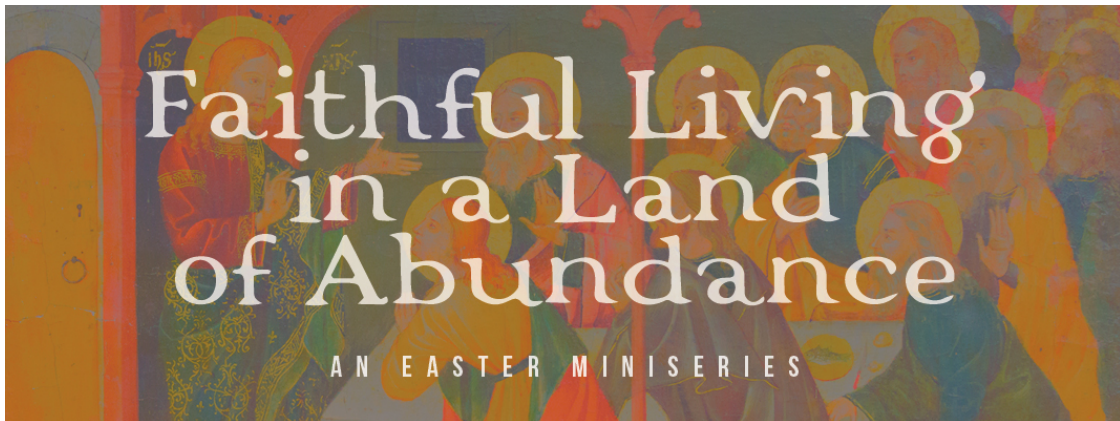

We will have a Combined Worship Service on Sunday, May 24 at 10 a.m. There will be **no** Sunday Morning Bible Study that day.



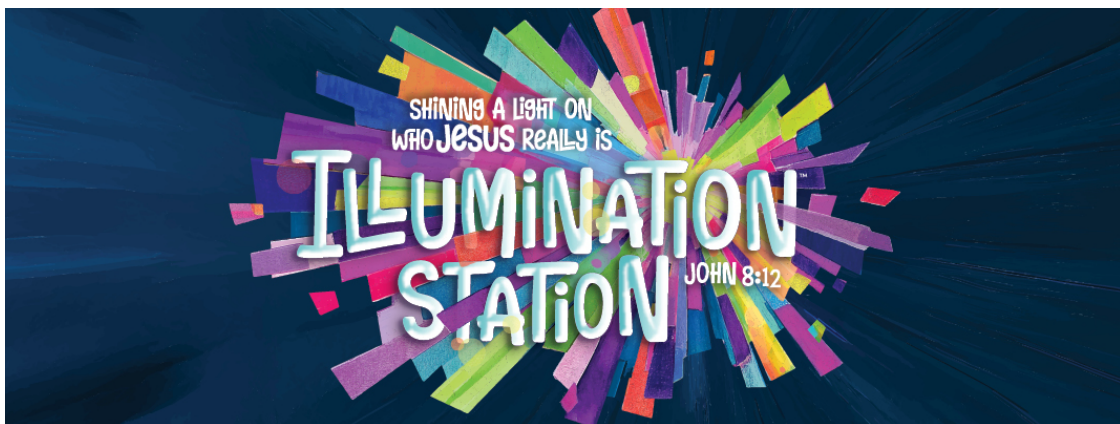
AgeReady: A Tool for Families to Plan End of Life **May 28 | 11:30 a.m. | Heritage Hall**

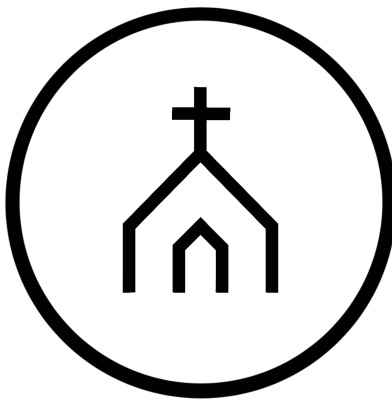

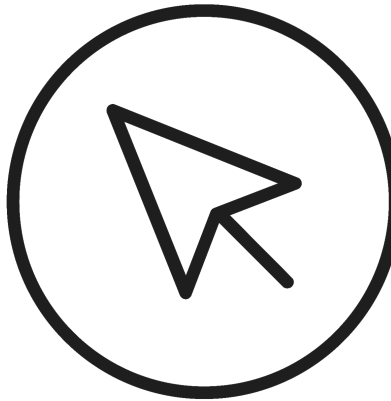

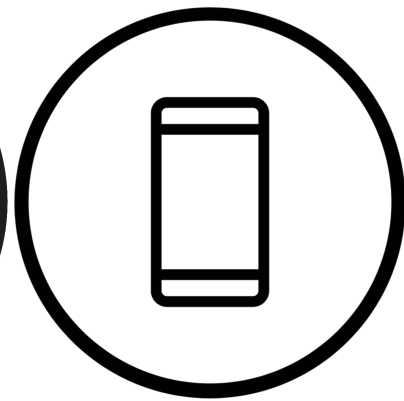
