Servant Leadership Commitments

So, you think you're ready to be a MBBC Servant Leader?

Student Ministry at Mountain Brook Baptist Church wants to see God work in our student's lives in such a way that they feel compelled to live out their faith in their everyday life. Part of the calling for all believers is to carry on the message and the mission of the apostles. The message of the apostles was simple, Jesus is the Christ crucified and resurrected, and the conviction that the kingdom of God is at hand. The mission of the apostles was so radical that their actions (along with the work of the Holy Spirit) turned, what was a small group, into a worldwide body of Christ. Servant Leadership wants to see our students live into these two truths.

JOB DESCRIPTION

Your goal is to Serve, Plan, and Grow through this intern program. You will serve through a ministry team designed to reach out to different parts of our church. You will PLAN parts of events and activities that the Student Ministry will participate in. And finally, you will GROW, through the action of prioritizing student ministry discipleship and pursuing Christlikeness.

Since the goals of this group are to intently live out the message and the mission of the apostles, we ask Servant Leaders to commit to the following things which we think will cultivate those two things:

COMMIT TO THE MESSAGE

- **Commitment to Jesus:** I acknowledge my relationship with Jesus Christ. I acknowledge his love for me, and I will be committed to seek to be more like him in all that I do.
- Commitment to MBBC Student Ministry + Spiritual Growth: I am committed to spiritual growth by engaging in daily Bible reading and prayer, Sunday Worship, mid-week Discipleship, accountability with other leaders, serving the Lord, and weekly tithing/offering at MBBC. I am committing to the following for 2024-2025....
- Attend 60% of Sunday Morning Bible Study and Worship
- Attend 75% of Mid-Week Bible Studies
- Attend 75% of the Brook Worship Services

COMMIT TO THE MISSION

- Commitment to a "No Doubt" Lifestyle: I commit myself to choices and lifestyles that are godly, knowing that my lifestyle is a model for other students (at MBBC and in the Mountain Brook Community) and that it communicates without a doubt, my commitment to Christ.
- **Commitment to a Ministry Team:** I am committed to being a leader in this ministry and all the requirements that it requires of me. I am committing to the following for 2024-2025....
- Attend and lead a once-a-month Ministry Team Meeting.
- Attend a once-a-quarter Servant Leader Meeting.
- Attend all retreats that I am capable of.
- Fulfill all leadership duties and tasks assigned.

This list represents what a completely engaged student would look like in our ministry. And as leaders, that is what we are asking of you. What would your life look like if you devoted your time and energy to growing your faith AND serving? How might the relationships in your life benefit from committing yourself to being a servant?
